

Adolescent Intensive Outpatient Care

Treatment focuses on teens who have a substance abuse problem or a mental health concern in conjunction with substance abuse.

Adolescents enrolled in our on-line IOP programs attend three group therapy sessions per week with one family component weekly, allowing them to balance the demands of schooling and extracurricular activities. Treatment is a collaborative process that includes the teen, their family, and referral sources working together with the clinical staff. The program is flexible and allows for individualized treatment options to ensure the best possible outcome for the teen.
